We also welcome you to come out and support the parish by joining those who come to play Bingo.

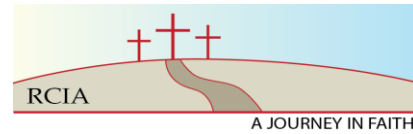
